





#### Standard Working Hours

08:00 to 18:00, Monday to Friday.

#### **Extended Working Hours**



This work or movement of marine plant will occur only when necessary due to tidal restrictions or long concrete pours

#### **Mobilisation and Demobilisation Hours**

Up to one hour before and after our standard hours and 30 minutes after extended hours working 07:00 to 08:00 and 18:00 to 19:00 Monday to Friday or 22:-00-22:30 Monday to Friday

#### Maintenance periods

On occasions due to health & safety requirements we will also carry out maintenance between 08:00 to 17:00 Saturdays and 10:00 to 16:00 Sundays

## **Progress**

- The cofferdam is complete
- Surcharge blocks have been moved from East side to west side of cofferdam
- Cofferdam Hoarding works will commence in the period
- Soil mixing works is progressing and is 33% complete and on program
- Drilling for grout block installation commenced on the 9th April
- Extraction of sheet piles associated with NESR (north eastern storm relief) works is planned to start 6th May
  - estimate 2 weeks work
- Archaeological excavation is due to start end of May

## **Programme Delay**

- Archaeological work has been delayed from the start of soil mixing to the end of soil mixing period and will commence Late May
- Landscaping plan submissions will now be submitted to LB Tower Hamlets in late 2019

## **Completed works**


- Cofferdam remedials and accessories
- 33% of soil mixing completed
- Water connection through park eliminating delivery lorries
- Installation of Archaeological sheet piling works
- North East Storm Relief Sewer diversion
- Muck Bin base slab completed

## Upcoming work

## **Upcoming works**

- Start May removal of NESR sheet piling estimated 2 weeks
- End May Archaeological Investigation for 4 to 6 weeks
- July removal of surcharge
- July completion of ground improvement works (Deep Soil Mixing)
- Preparation for Diaphragm walling







## **KEMPF – Non Material Amendment to the Development Consent Order (DCO)**

- Additional ground improvement works mean that construction at the site will take longer than anticipated
- To minimise the additional construction duration, Tideway propose to submit a Non Material Amendment (NMA) to the DCO for a change to the main tunnel alignment
- If approved, this will mean the main tunnel will be constructed approximately 15m further southeast than the alignment approved under the DCO
- The realignment will mean the tunnel will not pass directly through the KEMPF drop shaft, but will instead pass to the east of the shaft. A new connection tunnel (approx 15m in length) will then connect the drop shaft to the main tunnel
- This will enable the drop shaft and main tunnel to be built at the same time and will minimise the additional construction duration at KEMPF
- All changes will be approx 60m below ground
- This NMA will not change the size or location of the shaft or any above ground features


# KEMPF – Non Material Amendment to the Development Consent Order (DCO)

### **Schematic of DCO alignment and NMA alignment**




Schematic of DCO Alignment –
