HEATHWALL PUMPING STATION

PROGRESS UPDATE AND MARINE WORKS

Our works at the Heathwall Pumping Station site are progressing well. We recently contacted you with information regarding our upcoming marine piling works which will commence mid-June. There may be increased noise and vibration as a result of these works which we will continue to monitor to ensure we remain within our permitted limits.

In early July, we will install monitoring equipment in the Cross Thames Link Tunnel before we begin tunnelling ourselves. We will need to access the sewer running below Nine Elms Lane and for this we will be required to close one lane of traffic overnight. Traffic management will be set up by 22:00 and our subcontractor will set up a crane to lift the covers on a manhole to the west of the Heathwall site. Access will be made using the crane and man riding basket between midnight and 04:00 and the team will be lifted out and covers replaced between 04:00-05:00 after which point the lane will be reopened to traffic.

This sequence will be repeated each weekday shift from the 2nd of July for a period of approximately 3 weeks.

We continue to work closely with Transport for London and London Borough of Wandsworth.
