HAMMERSMITH PUMPING STATION UPDATE

Work at our Hammersmith Pumping Station site is progressing well as we continue work on the Connection Tunnel, Inlet Channel and the Interception Chamber.

As part of our works, we need to carry out maintenance on the cables located on the roof of the existing Thames Water Pumping Station.

In agreement with London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham, maintenance work on the cables will take place every Saturday and Sunday throughout the month of September between 8am and 4pm.

While we carry out these works you will notice a small team working on the Thames Water Pumping station roof.

We do not anticipate these works to be intrusive and we will keep noise to a minimum through careful management arrangements.
