CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Ground improvements to strengthen the area below the cofferdam are almost complete.

We continue to set up the site for the next phase of works which is the construction of the shaft. This includes creating new work surfaces and foundations, whilst finishing the backfilling of the remaining sections of the cofferdam. These works will continue for the next month.

The shaft will be the future connection to the Thames Tideway Tunnel.

Construction will consist of first installing the diaphragm walls, followed by excavation to 64 metres deep.

From late September, we will start to receive equipment for shaft works. Some of the larger equipment will arrive to site outside of normal working hours (before 7.00 am and after 7.00 pm), this is to minimise traffic disruption as they will be abnormal loads.

Once we begin to install the shaft, we have permitted working hours up to 22:00. These hours are for managing these critical activities, with our intention to always finish works as early as possible in the evening. However, this can be dependent on progress throughout the day and delays such as traffic.

More information will be provided nearer to starting shaft works.
