GREENWICH PUMPING STATION

CHANGES TO TRAFFIC ON NORMAN ROAD

To support construction works at the Tideway Greenwich Pumping Station site and Norman House development site, later this month part of Norman Road will be closed for public vehicle use.

The closure will be for both the north and southbound lanes between Greenwich High Road and north of Lovibond Lane. Access will remain available from Creek Road.

The existing vehicle holding area (VHA) used for Tideway shaft works will be now be used for the Norman House development.

The Tideway VHA will relocate within the northbound lane of Norman Road, to between two of our site gates (below both railway bridges).

This is to support the increase in vehicle movements to the Tideway site in preparation for and during tunnelling works and to support the Norman House development. The VHAs will allow us to manage deliveries to site more efficiently.

During our working hours (from 07:30 to 18:00) access will remain available to Bellville House from Creek Road. Exiting vehicles will be escorted by Tideway traffic marshals (heading north towards Creek Road), this is because part of the northbound lane will be in use for the VHA.

Outside of working hours, the Tideway VHA will be closed, allowing traffic on both the south and northbound lanes towards Creek Road.

Lovibond Lane will be two-way for traffic, allowing vehicles to enter and leave using Waller Way (via Greenwich High Road), but with no access to / from Norman Road.

We will have additional traffic marshals on Lovibond Lane during the opening and closing hours of the Bright Horizons nursery and booked rubbish collections will be escorted via Norman Road.

These traffic changes will be in place from Monday 23 September, for around 18 months.


Construction vehicles are pre-booked and scheduled throughout the day, checked for safety compliance upon arrival and will enter site as soon as reasonably practical. With the exception of concrete wagons, all vehicles will switch off their engines inside the VHAs.

We apologise for any inconvenience during this time. We will do our best to manage access during this period.

The traffic management changes (signage, cones, fencing and barriers) will happen on Sunday 22 September at night when traffic flows are lowest.
