## DEPTFORD CHURCH STREET EXTENDED HOURS TO POUR THE BASE SLAB

At the bottom of the shaft, we continue to form the base slab which will be a reinforced concrete structure, 3 metres deep and 18.5 metres in diameter.

Further to previous information sheets, we anticipate that pouring concrete to complete the base slab may continue up to 22:00.

Concrete needs to be poured in one continuous operation until complete to ensure a consistent quality.

This is currently planned for mid-September.

To reduce the risk of overrunning past 22:00, we now plan to start pouring concrete from 7:00 am (instead of 8:00). This change follows lessons learnt at one of our other construction sites, with our aim to minimise any possible disruption in the evening.

Our intention is to always finish works as early as possible. However, this can be dependent on progress throughout the day and delays such as traffic.

Staff will be on site for pre-work briefings and setting up from around 6:00 am.

Once the base slab is complete, we will start to form the tunnel portals, which will be the two openings at the bottom of the shaft to connect to the Tideway tunnel.

## KEY INFO

### WORKING HOURS

- From 07:00 to 22:00 for pouring concrete (up to one hour start up and shut down periods also permitted)

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- One day of pouring concrete to complete the base slab

- Concrete wagon deliveries throughout the day, into the evening

### WHAT WE WILL DO

- Use acoustic screens where possible to minimise noise
- Continue to use best practice to minimise nuisance and monitor noise and dust levels

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
