BUSINESS ADMINISTRATORS

Roles and Responsibilities

Provides clerical and administrative support to teams on the project, either as part of a team or individually. They are involved with the coordination and implementation of office procedures and frequently have responsibility for specific projects and tasks.

Entry requirements

Five GCSEs (or equivalent), including English and Maths

Qualifications you will gain

Level 3 in Business and Administration, Level 3 Technical Certificate, Level 2 Functional Skills in English, Maths, and ICT

Starting salary and working hours

- 40-45 hours
- From **£15,000** per year
- 18-month contract*

TUNNEL OPERATIVE

Roles and Responsibilities

A tunnelling operative is to assist with the excavation, support and forming of tunnels and shafts in the ground.

Entry requirements

Five GCSEs (or equivalent), including English and Maths

Qualifications you will gain

A level 2 NVQ Diploma in Tunnelling Operations

Starting salary and working hours

- Shift work or early morning starts
- Minimum 40 hours per week
- From **£15,000** per year
- Two-year contract*

CIVIL ENGINEERS

Roles and Responsibilities

Civil engineers design, build, supervise, operate, and maintain construction projects and systems in the public and private sector systems for water supply and sewage treatment.

Entry requirements

5 GCSEs grades A*-B, including maths and English, or their equivalent

Qualifications you will gain

Level 3 diploma in civil engineering for technicians.

Starting salary and working hours

- Shift work or early morning starts
- Minimum 40 hours per week
- From **£15,000** per year
- Two-year contract*

GENERAL OPERATIVES

Roles and Responsibilities

A general construction operative (or labourer) does many jobs on a building site, from mixing concrete to digging holes. They are masters of many trades, with an extraordinarily wide range of skills

Entry requirements

5 GCSEs (or equivalent), including English and Maths

Qualifications you will gain

Level 2 NVQ in Construction Operations

Starting salary and working hours

- Shift work or early morning starts
- Minimum 40 hours per week
- From **£15,000** per year
- Two-year contract*

CONSTRUCTION ELECTRICIAN

Roles and Responsibilities

They will need to read blueprints and install wiring and electrical controls in residential or commercial buildings while following state and local building regulations.

Entry requirements

Five GCSEs (or equivalent), including English and Maths

Qualifications you will gain

Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Installing Electro technical Systems & Equipment

Starting salary and working hours

- Shift work or early morning starts
- Minimum 40 hours per week
- From **£15,000** per year
- Four-year contract*

QUANTITY SURVEYORS

Roles and Responsibilities

Their role is to make sure that the financial position of the project is accurately reported and controlled effectively. They manage the contractual relationships between the subcontractors involved in the construction project.

Entry requirements

5 GCSEs grades A*-B, including maths and English, or their equivalent

Qualifications you will gain

A Level 3 BTEC Diploma in Construction and the Built Environment and An NVQ Diploma in Construction Contracting Operations

Starting salary and working hours

- 40 – 45 hours per week
- From **£15,000** per year
- Two-year contract*

*With the opportunity to progress into full time employment

DID YOU KNOW

London relies on a 150-year-old network of brickwork sewers, and it needs updating. Built for four million people, the system is struggling to cope with a population more than double that size.

As a result, it often overflows, releasing millions of tonnes of raw sewage into the river each year.

To tackle this problem we are building a giant tunnel - the Thames Tideway Tunnel - from west to east, to divert that sewage

and transport it directly to a treatment plant in east London.

The project is creating significant opportunities across the capital, boosting local employment and prosperity.

About 4,000 direct, sustainable jobs will be created on the project during peak construction in 2019 – and we have committed that a quarter of those jobs will go to residents from the 14 boroughs along the tunnel's route.
