<p>Traffic Marshalls <i>This role requires a variety of communication techniques to ensure safe movement of vehicles around a site. This is a safety critical role and may require a hearing test. <p>General Operatives <i>A general construction operative (or labourer) does many jobs on a building site, from mixing concrete to digging holes. They are masters of many trades, with an extraordinarily wide range of skills.</i></p>	Green CSCS card	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shift work or early morning starts • Minimum 45 hours • From £22,000 per year

SKILLED TRADE OR PROGRESSION ROUTE FROM ENTRY LEVEL

<p>Slinger Signallers <i>Responsible for directing the movement of vehicles and loads from delivery lorries by different plant machines. This is a safety critical role and may require a hearing test. Must be able to give clear communications.</i></p>	Construction Plant Competence Scheme (CPCS) card with the relevant qualification for a slinger/signaller	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shift work or early morning starts • Minimum 45 hours • From £24,000 per year
<p>Tunnelling Operatives <i>Assist with the excavation, support and forming of tunnels and shafts in the ground.</i></p>	Blue skilled CSCS card with a level 2 NVQ Diploma in Tunnelling Operations and possibly a Tunnel Safety Training Scheme card	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shift work or early morning starts • Minimum 45 hours • From £22,000 per year
<p>Steel Fixers <i>Work using steel bars and mesh in reinforced concrete to strengthen buildings and other big structures.</i></p>	Blue skilled CSCS card with the relevant qualification in steel fixing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shift work or early morning starts • Minimum 45 hours • From £25,000 per year
<p>Formworkers <i>Make temporary structures from wood or metal for use in moulding concrete.</i></p>	Blue skilled CSCS card with the relevant qualification in formwork	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shift work or early morning starts • Minimum 45 hours • From £25,000 per year
<p>Plant Operators <i>Use heavy machinery to dig, lift and move materials on a construction site.</i></p>	CPCS card in relevant category of plant machine needed for the role	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shift work or early morning starts • Minimum 45 hours • From £26,000 per year

FURTHER PROGRESSION

<p>Gangers/Supervisors <i>In charge of a specific team for a task or area of the work site.</i></p>	Blue or Gold CSCS card and relevant experience	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shift work or early morning starts • From £35,000 per year
<p>Foremen <i>Ensures that the workers at a construction site follow correct work procedures and safety precautions. Foremen are expected to assess job priorities and assign workers accordingly.</i></p>	Gold CSCS card with an NVQ level 3 or relative experience	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shift work or early morning starts • Minimum 45 hours • From £45,000 per year

DID YOU KNOW

London relies on a 150-year-old network of brickwork sewers, and it needs updating. Built for four million people, the system is struggling to cope with a population more than double that size. As a result, it often overflows, releasing millions of tonnes of raw sewage into the river each year.

To tackle this problem we are building a giant tunnel - the Thames Tideway Tunnel - from west to east, to divert that sewage

and transport it directly to a treatment plant in east London.

The project is creating significant opportunities across the capital, boosting local employment and prosperity.

About 4,000 direct, sustainable jobs will be created on the project during peak construction in 2019 – and we have committed that a quarter of those jobs will go to residents from the 14 boroughs along the tunnel's route.
