KING GEORGES PARK WORKS UPDATE & DECEMBER/JANUARY WORKING ARRANGEMENTS

As we continue to make progress at our King George's Park site, we would like to notify you of some upcoming works.

On Monday 6 January we will start preparing the site in order to commence piling works on Wednesday 8 January. Steel piles will be installed over two weeks, which will form the permanent work structure of the kiosk. Temporary steel sheet piles will then be installed over three weeks to extend the existing cofferdam within the site. The works will take place during our normal working hours: Monday-Friday 8am-6pm, Saturday 8am-4pm.

We do not anticipate these works to be intrusive and though some noise and vibration is expected through these works, we will endeavour to keep both to a minimum through careful management and monitoring arrangements.

Over the Christmas period there will be no construction works taking place. Our last day of construction work will be on Friday 20 December and they will recommence in the New Year on Monday 6 January. During this period, we will continue to have a security presence and some office personnel in the offices only.

We would also like to thank all our residents for their cooperation throughout 2019 and wish you all a very Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.
