Applicant Reference	The Panel considered information pack 2350-TDWAY-TTTUN-990- ZZ-ZZ-721398 , which included medical information, in respect of a claim for continuing respite.
Relevant Tideway site	Kirtling Street
Decision	The requested mitigation was DEFERRED.
Details of the award	The Panel had recently undertaken a further site visit to Kirtling Street (its third this year) and specifically visited a flat in this building which informed its previous decision. The Panel has considered further a request for a site visit to the claimant's property and has determined that subject to arrangements being made to visit the property this will be carried out as soon as reasonably possible.

Applicant Reference	The Panel considered information pack 2350-TDWAY-TTTUN-990- ZZ-ZZ-721397 in respect of a claim for cleaning, blackout blinds and a portable air conditioner/fan.
Relevant Tideway site	Kirtling Street
Decision	The requested mitigation was AWARDED in part.
	The claimant's property overlooks the acoustic shed, the tunnel segment area and the conveyor system. There is no reported medical evidence.
	There are no reported exceedances, due to the works, of the agreed noise and pollutant concentration levels at the local Kirtling Street monitoring stations.
	The Panel considered that it is highly unlikely that dust from the Tideway operation is causing dust deposition at the property. Accordingly, no award for window cleaning or pressure cleaning of the balcony is made.
	With respect to light trespass there is a local process in place and therefore the Tideway team is requested to implement their blackout blinds assessment.
Details of the award	The Panel notes that in warmer weather keeping windows closed can lead to high internal temperatures. Accordingly, with respect to a request for a fan/air conditioning unit this part of the claim is awarded.
	The Panel awards £300 to purchase a fan/air conditioning unit to enable windows to be kept shut when Tideway activities are in progress together with £55 per year running costs (pro rata) for 2 years - the period that the principal activities at the site are expected to be in operation.
