

Putney Embankment Foreshore - Timeline



More by river

- Change to overall works method, using larger barges, has resulted in fewer barge movements on the river
- Each barge movement equates to approximately 50 HGV's removed from the local road network
- Since October we have had 19 barges arrive at Putney Embankment Foreshore, keeping approximately 950 lorries off the road


Upcoming Works

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NOTICE OF 24-HOUR CLOSURE OF PUTNEY BRIDGE

As part of our essential work to build London's new 'super sewer' we are writing to let you know about a part-closure of Putney Bridge from 4am on Sunday 2 February to 4am on Monday 3 February 2020.

The southbound side of the bridge will be closed to general traffic with alternative routes in place. The bridge will remain open to pedestrians, cyclists and buses.

Please see map overleaf for further details of the diversions.

The northbound side of the bridge will be open to traffic but restricted to one lane only, alternating with southbound buses, so delays are expected.

Bus services in both directions will continue to operate with local diversions and some delays are expected. For more information on bus services during this

time, please check Transport for London's journey planner: www.tfl.gov.uk/plan-a-journey

The closure will be lifted at 4am on Monday 3 February with the bridge re-opened to all traffic.

The closure is essential to allow us to safely remove major equipment from our site at Putney Bridge, which requires us to install and use a large crane on the south side of the bridge.

Thank you for your patience while we carry out these essential works and we apologise in advance for any inconvenience.




