Details of the award	Previously approved continuation of holiday respite for the family has had to be cancelled due to the COVID–19 situation. Tideway had invited the claimant to consider other forms of alternative mitigation and a number of measures were outlined in the information pack 2350-TDWAY-TTTUN-990-ZZ-ZZ-721587.
	The Panel considered the request very carefully in the light of medical evidence previously provided and determined that Tideway would reimburse the costs of several additional items already purchased.
	The request to purchase additional computer equipment was <u>not</u> approved without further evidence/confirmation that these items are required at this moment in time for schooling purposes and cannot be provided by the school or other routes. Subject to that information being provided, the ICP would be prepared to revisit its decision which would take into account the on-going lockdown situation and circumstances.

Details of the award	The Panel is aware of the situation at this building and the extent to which noise from the muck bin area affects residents. Accordingly, the Panel awards the cost of an air conditioning/cooling system in line with other awards at this building.



	No award for cleaning is made as the ICP is of the view that dust migration from the site is sufficiently mitigated so as to not result in significant levels of dust deposition occurring from the site.

Relevant Tideway site	Putney Bridge
Decision	The requested business loss compensation was.
	Tideway had received the forensic accountants report and the Compensation Specialists have both reviewed the report. The Panel has determined that the conclusion reached is consistent with the methodology used previously; the only real difference being that the assumed business rates reduction/refund has been deducted, correctly in the Panel's view. It is determined by the Panel that the recommendation of the award in the report is approved.
	For information
Details of the award	The report's conclusion raises the COVID-19 issue and the next claim will presumably be for Q1 2020 which will include the last 10 days of March, when all restaurants were shut and this would obviously have had an impact on turnover etc, regardless of Tideway's activities. The COVID-19 effect is likely to be very much greater in Q2, possibly with the restaurant being closed for a significant part, or even the whole of the quarter. It will be important to ensure that Tideway does not compensate the claimant for losses that it would have suffered anyway and presumably for which it can claim government support.
