The Panel does not consider that an award for a tower fan for each person is proportionate based on the degree of anticipated exposure to higher noise levels.
	The Panel notes the claimant's comments with respect to damage to the flooring, which in the Panel's view is highly unlikely to have occurred as a result of site operations.
