	It would appear that part of the implementation of the award related to rehousing was missed by Tideway. The work to reinstate the footpath commenced on January 7th 2020 and is due to be completed in a fortnight or so, from today's date, by LBFH's contractors.
	Tideway has requested that the Panel considers offering the family an alternative to the rehousing that they should otherwise have received.
	The Panel is fully aware of the personal circumstances of the family and has determined that this is a very exceptional case such that a respite award was made.

Details of the award	The claimant identifies that the family is disturbed by noise at all times of the day and night and is also affected by dust from the site. The claimant has made a number of complaints since August 2019 and has provided video evidence dating from July 2019. No medical evidence has been provided.
	The claimant is requesting a variety of mitigation measures.
	The Panel made a part award to assist with the noise impacts of the site. The claimant has been informed that the Panel does not make retrospective awards; however, that is not strictly correct. It is the case that the Panel can make retrospective awards in very exceptional circumstances; however, this claim is not considered to be such a case.
