Site visit	Panel members (GP & SS) made a site visit to a claimant's property near the Chambers Wharf site. The Panel also took the opportunity of visiting the general site area and noted that other than a few very limited noise events the site was very quiet during the period of the Panel's visit. The Panel visited the claimant's property (See Item 6) and the Panel obtained information with respect to the claimant's on-going health issues and concerns.

	The Panel is aware of the claimant's health issues and the noise environment in the Carnwath Road area. The Panel has not been able to make a site visit to determine the noise impacts at the claimant's property, due to an inability to access the claimant's property or a proxy property.
Details of the award	Accordingly, the claimant is provided with an interim award on a very precautionary basis. The award for the claimant only is made for a maximum period of 6 months from the date of this decision or until tunnelling activities at the site and the use of the muck bin area ceases whichever is the soonest.

Following the visit and recognising his various health related issues as discussed with him, the Panel has determined that as a precautionary measure an award should be made in order to assist the claimant in reducing any anxiety or stress that he associates with the construction activities. The award will be reviewed on a yearly basis taking into account on- going site activities.
	The award includes the person that the claimant has identified to the ICP as his carer/partner.
	The Panel would like to remind the claimant that the provision of secondary glazing to the lounge would further improve the internal noise climate.

Additionally, because the overall noise levels are low there is not a case for the award of a fan or air conditioning unit.
	Recognising that the claimant works from home an award of one pair of noise cancelling headphones is made to assist with working from home.
	The Panel does not make monetary awards except where there have been financial losses e.g. loss of rent and therefore no financial award is made.
