	The claimant reports that over the last year or so noise, light and dust have started to have an impact on his wellbeing and health and that of his partner. The claimant's medical history is noted.
	The Panel has reviewed a number of videos provided by the claimant and the Panel Chair has previously communicated with the claimant.
Details of the award	Members of the Panel carried out an unannounced site visit on the 3 rd February 2021 to determine the extent to which noise from the site would result in disturbance to occupiers of property in the immediate vicinity of the site. The visit confirmed that, at that time, noise levels in the area were relatively low, although at some locations around the site, it was possible to detect a low level humming noise. The Panel has previously reviewed noise and air quality reports for the area which confirmed that both noise and particulate levels are relatively low. The Panel does however recognise that occasional events, such as abnormal load deliveries, can be disturbing.
	The Panel has determined that secondary glazing is not awarded as the TAP noise limits are not predicted to be exceeded at this property.



	Air conditioning units are not awarded as noise and air quality levels are not considered to be regularly at such elevated levels to preclude the opening of windows for ventilation purposes.
	The Panel had previously awarded two pairs of noise cancelling headphones to a maximum cost of £100/pair to assist with working from home and that offer remains open.

Details of the award	The Panel is aware that water main works have been taking place in the vicinity of the claimant's property to an extent that the ability to work from home has been compromised for the nature of work which the claimant carries out. The Panel previously carried out an unannounced visit to the site and observed that, at that time, the water main works were at a stage where noise emissions were not significant. The Panel understands that the water main works should be completed by the end of March 2021 but that elevated noise levels may occur during the final reinstatement phase.
	The Panel reviewed a video and the photographs provided by the claimant.
	The Panel makes an award of a pair of noise cancelling headphones to a maximum contribution of £100 to assist with working from home.

	The property was previously identified as qualifying for secondary glazing under the TAP scheme.
	Members of the Panel carried out an unannounced site visit on the 3 rd February 2021 to determine the extent to which noise from the site would result in disturbance to occupiers of property in the immediate vicinity of the site.
	The Panel has considered the award with respect to what has been requested and all awards are made with respect to the individual requirements of the claimant and acknowledging the difficulties that result from lockdown.
	The Panel's award includes several items requested by the claimant however the request for energy costs was not substantiated and was therefore refused.
