	The Panel reviewed a recording of construction noise which was provided by the claimant and also visited the site area on the 15 <sup>th</sup> April 2021 to further understand the nature of construction noise in the area.
	The Panel is aware that there will be some noisy activity occasionally in the area although it is the Panel's consideration that, to a greater extent, the claimant is and will experience construction noise from development work on the south side of Nine Elms Lane rather than from the Tideway site.
	The Panel has decided however that, on a very precautionary basis, it makes an award of one set of noise cancelling headphones to a maximum cost of £100.
