Decision	AWARDED
Details of the award	The claimant works for the NHS with a combination of home working and overnight shift patterns. Her husband works from home. They report that they cannot open the windows because of the noise and the flat becomes very hot in the summer causing increased health risk to their young child who has severe allergies. The claimant is concerned that disturbance is likely to get worse over the next 18 months. A home visit was carried out by the Panel on May 5 <sup>th</sup> at 3 pm and site observations were made including lorry movements.
	Noise monitoring data and a number of videos were reviewed.
	The Panel has taken a very precautionary approach and makes an award of rehousing for 12 months from the date of this award. At a later date, the Panel will consider whether the award should be extended.
