	The Panel met by video conference on an urgent basis to discuss this claim on 17 th May 2021 and the purpose of these Minutes is to ratify the decision made at that meeting which is an award in principle of alternative working space.

Following the previous deferral (see Minutes #176), the Chair and the Noise & Vibration Specialist visited the claimant's property on 14 th May 2021 in order to understand the noise climate at and in the claimant's property.
Details of the award	The Panel has also reviewed the various noise monitoring data for the site and received information about site activities from the contractors.
	The Panel determined that the claimant should be offered an award of 2No. air conditioning units of the water reservoir type, and electricity costs.
