Details of the award	The family health issues are known to the Panel and have been fully taken into account in its decision making.
	At ICP meeting #177 on 11 May 2021, the Panel agreed to consider meeting the cost of a nursery place for the claimant's child if further information could be provided by the claimant as to which nursery was being considered and what period the fee would cover.
	The Panel has considered all of the information available to it and, on a very precautionary basis, makes an award of meeting the additional nursery costs for the son for the period September 2021 to July 2022 excluding holiday periods. In making this decision, the Panel has taken into account the benefits that would accrue in respect of the claimant's wellbeing.

Decision	AWARDED
	The claimant has varying shift patterns. His partner also works late/night shifts but additionally spends a good deal of time studying from home when not at work.
Details of the award	From previous assessments, residents have been informed by e-mail note that Tideway would be conducting some noisy activities in May, June and July 2021 as the site is dismantled on the corner of Chancellor's Road and Distillery Road and that these works may cause significant disturbance to the residents.
	The Panel reviewed the information pack and photographs. The latest s.61 indicates high construction noise levels are likely to occur at some receptors around the site until the end of July 2021.
	The Panel has determined that, in order to assist with working from home, an award is made of two portable air conditioning units to a maximum cost of £300/unit plus electricity costs of £110 for the two units for one year. Additionally two sets of



	noise cancelling headphones are also awarded to assist with working from home.

Decision	NOT AWARDED
Details of the award	The bulk of the claimant's work is conducted from home and his wife, although she is currently on maternity leave, has e-learning and work obligations which she regularly engages in from home.
	Whilst the claimant does have some built in flexibility to conduct some of his work outside of the anticipated noisy hours, this isn't always practical and certainly not when engaging in telephone conversations and meetings.
	From previous assessments, residents have been informed by e-mail note that Tideway would be conducting some noisy activities in May, June and July 2021 as the site is dismantled and that these works may cause significant disturbance to the residents if their apartments adjoin or face the site.
	It is noted that the St George development site is now well progressed and completely shields the apartment from the Tideway site and particularly the area of Tideway works which are likely to be noisy. Noise from construction activity, at least during the day, will be dominated by the St George residential development activity and, at other times, distance and the location of the St George development will mitigate noise from the Tideway site.
	The Panel has determined that an award is not made due to the significant distance from the Tideway works and the shielding afforded by the St George development.

	The claimant made previous applications to the ICP.
Details of the award	From previous assessments, residents have been informed by e-mail note that Tideway would be conducting some noisy activities in May, June and July 2021 as the site is dismantled and that these works may cause significant disturbance to the residents.
	The Panel reviewed the location of the claimant's property in relation to the works and also a video of noisy activities. Whilst the video was of very limited duration and was clearly taken from the balcony of the property, it did demonstrate the type and level of noise experienced at the property. The latest s.61 indicates high construction noise levels are likely to occur at some receptors around the site.
	The Panel has determined that the request for offsite office space for the claimant and her partner is awarded on a monthly subscription basis until the end of July 2021 when the Panel anticipate that works will have been substantially completed.
