Details of the award	The Panel considered the claim and it was the opinion of the compensation experts that the 'unaffected' monthly rental value of the flat differed to the amount claimed. The Panel therefore made an award being the difference between the Panel's opinion of the unaffected rent and the rent actually achieved. The award is for the duration of the current letting and it is recommended that Tideway considers paying the award periodically (perhaps 6 monthly) after being satisfied that the current tenancy has not been terminated. Details of the award	The Panel noted the location of the property in relation to the Heathwall works. The claimant is not classified as a special or medical case. The Panel is aware of the location; however, it did not have access to relevant information which would have assisted in determining the claim, e.g., s.61, noise monitoring data and associated videos. The Panel has decided to defer a decision until a home visit can be carried out to the claimant's property. Additionally, it would assist the Panel if the claimant could indicate what respite he is requesting.
