	The Panel has nevertheless determined to adopt a very precautionary approach and award the claimant 1 day respite/week for her and her carer.
	In respect of the increased electricity costs of running the air purifiers, the Tideway Mitigation team are reviewing the electricity costs for all claimants in respect of recent increases in energy costs.
