Details of the award	The Panel has previously viewed a number of videos from other claimants in respect of noise from the site and has also taken into account a Doctor's letter provided with the claim.
	The Panel has made recent visits to the CHAWF site and found noise and dust levels and activity to be low. However, the Panel is aware that there will be ongoing demobilisation activity, mostly daytime, which may at times increase noise levels. The claimant has mentioned the 24/7 operation of the treatment plant; however, the slurry treatment plant is no longer operational and accordingly this should not be a cause of noise or dust.
	With respect to dust levels affecting the children's asthma, the Panel does not believe that dust levels would be elevated at this property therefore, no award is made for the costs of the air purifier.
	The Panel has, nevertheless, determined to make an award to be taken before the end of August 2022.
	If the claimant would like a home visit from the Panel to observe how the family are being affected by the site activities, then this can be arranged after August 2022.

Details of the award	The claimant has previously been awarded long term accommodation by the ICP. As per the implementation guidelines, Tideway pay costs associated with long term housing on an Assured Shorthold Tenancy (AST) basis. That tenancy had come to an end and the claimant was seeking short-term accommodation whilst looking for a new AST. The Chair of the Panel discussed with the Tideway Mitigation Team the requirement to obtain short-term accommodation for the claimant and the Chair made a decision that the claimant could be offered access to Silverdoor accommodation in the short-term. At today's ICP meeting, the Panel ratified the decision taken by the Chair on the 1st July 2022.
