## WORKING ARRANGEMENTS – TEMPORARY CHANGE

Works at our Carnwath Road Riverside site are progressing well. The secondary lining that will give the tunnel an additional layer of concrete to ensure its design life for the next 120 years is now 74% complete.

As our works continue, we would like to update you on a temporary change to our working arrangements.

Due to the closure of a section of the junction at Carnwath Road and Wandsworth Bridge Road we have had to make alternative arrangements to ensure deliveries can continue to be made to the site safely. Please note the planned road closure is not related to our works.

Between Monday 25 July and Sunday 6 August, we will be working extended hours to allow for deliveries to arrive and depart site. The timing of these deliveries is when there will be less traffic on the diverted route that our lorries will have to take.

Our extended hours to accommodate the delivery of cement powder will be Monday to Friday 06:00 to 22:00, Saturday 08:00 to 22:00 and Sunday 08:00 to 18:00.

The onsite activities remain unchanged as a reminder the following arrangements are in place.

Our normal surface working hours will remain Monday to Friday 08:00 to 18:00 and Saturday 08:00 to 13:00. The unloading of the material from the barges will continue to be carried out seven days a week using the harbour crane. The team will endeavour to carry out the unloading of the barge between 08:00 and 20:00 every day but there may be occasions when this will need to be undertaken outside of these times.

Depending on the aggregate stock levels inside the shed, at times it may also be necessary to move aggregate from outside to inside the acoustic shed. As with the unloading of the barges, this will be carried out between 08:00 and 20:00 seven days a week.

The use of the harbour crane to remove any excess concrete as a result of the secondary lining activities will also continue. As the secondary lining is being carried out on a 24/7 basis, there may be occasions when the door of the acoustic shed will need to be opened outside of core hours to enable us to also carry this out.

### What to expect

- Delivery lorries arriving and leaving the site Monday - Friday 6am-8am, 6pm-10pm, Saturday 1pm-10pm and Sunday 8am-6pm
- Works on the surface: Monday-Friday 8am-6pm and Saturdays 8am-1pm

- Occasional unloading of barges 24/7 outside of our core working hours
- Occasional use of the harbour crane 24/7 outside of our core working hours
- Occasional opening of the shed door 24/4 outside of our core working hours

### What will we do

- Tell you if our plans change
- We will monitor noise, vibration and dust levels
- Best practical means to minimise noise
