BLACKFRIARS BRIDGE FORESHORE PILE REMOVAL – SUMMER 2022

The Super Sewer Tideway works at our Blackfriars Bridge Foreshore site have continued apace during the first half of the year.

We are now reaching a stage when we will be removing the eastern section of the sheet piles that we inserted in the riverbed in 2018. These were used to create one of the cofferdams that have allowed us to build uninterrupted within the river.

To extract the piles, we will be using a vibration hammer to loosen the steel from the riverbed and allow us to lift the piles out and onto a barge for removal.

This work will create some extra noise during the operation of the vibration hammer. We will only be working during core site hours of 08:00-18:00 Monday – Friday and 08:00-13:00 on Saturdays.

We will be taking regular breaks throughout the day and will monitor noise and vibration levels constantly during the works.

The operation will commence in the first week of August and we expect that the piles will be removed by September.

Behind the piles you will see the new river wall that we have constructed to contain the sewer interception structures that we have been working on. The western section of the cofferdam will remain in place for a further year.
