| Details of the award  | The ICP carried out a home visit to the claimant's property on the 21 <sup>st</sup> of July 2022. The home visit was a direct result of an appeal in respect of an award which was made at Meeting #211. The Panel members consisted of the Chair and the Noise & Vibration Specialist. A representative from Southwark Council was also in attendance.                                  |
|                       | The Panel members received information from the claimant and her<br>husband and was shown a number of videos which identified noisy<br>events which occurred both during the daytime and night-time. The<br>Panel noted that dust monitoring indicated that dust (particulate)<br>levels remain significantly below levels which in the UK are<br>considered to result in health issues. |
|                       | The Panel has considered the claimant's circumstances very carefully and the Medical Specialist has been updated in respect of the home visit which was carried out in his absence.  |
|                       | The Panel has determined as a very precautionary measure in respect of the claimants' obvious stress and mental health, to award the claimant respite for <u>all</u> family members at the standard rate which may be commuted into a holiday break away from the claimant's home to be taken before the end of August 2022 at the equivalent cost.                                      |
