FOOTPATH CLOSURE

As we continue to make good progress with our works on the Carnwath Road Riverside site, the team are preparing for the next phase of works which includes the construction of the below ground air treatment chamber (ATC).

To enable the works to the ATC to be undertaken safely within the site, we need to extend the site hoarding to the kerb line of Carnwath Road. This will mean closing the southern footpath adjacent to the site and diverting pedestrians to the northern footway via the two existing pedestrian crossings.

Directional signage for pedestrians will also be put in place for the duration of the footpath closure which will remain in place until Summer 2024.

The realignment of the hoarding will start on Monday 24 October. The hoarding works will be undertaken Monday to Friday 08:00 to 18:00 and will take up to five weeks to complete.

As part of the hoarding works, we will need to temporarily relocate the pedestrian crossing outside of 50 Carnwath Road and suspend three of the parking bays next to the crossing. A temporary traffic light system will be put in place to manage the traffic along Carnwath Road along with a temporary cross point whilst the hoarding realignment works are undertaken. Please see the diagram overleaf.

During this time, we will also be installing an extra vehicle access gate at the west end of the site. The extra gate is required to allow vehicles to access the western end of the site as the ATC works will block the current internal access routes within the site.
