DEPTFORD CHURCH STREET

Construction of the Thames Tideway Tunnel is progressing well, with tunnel secondary lining works underway in our tunnels. This is where we are adding an additional layer of concrete onto the inside of the tunnels from Greenwich to Bermondsey and between Bermondsey and Abbey Mills, Stratford.

The main construction work at our Deptford site is planned to finish towards the end of 2023. We will then be testing the new system. Tideway's current timetable shows the super sewer to be operational in 2025.

Here is an update of local progress at the Deptford Church Street site.

Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO)

The demolition of the Deptford Storm Relief Sewer is now complete. This enables us to construct a chamber to divert future storm flows (that currently pollute the river Thames) into the CSO, down into the shaft and into the Thames Tideway Tunnel. The completed tunnel will take these overflows north of the River Thames (for the first time) and on to Beckton Sewage Treatment Works.

Shaft

Logistical support works for the tunnel secondary lining are finished. We have begun building internal structures within the shaft, which are needed to direct flows into the tunnel.

Air Treatment and Ventilation Chambers

The air treatment chamber, located west of the shaft, is now complete. Work on the ventilation chamber, south of the shaft, have begun. Once operational, these structures will remove any odours coming from the tunnel.

Surface works

The construction of an electrical kiosk is under way at ground level. This small building will be the control room for the operation of the systems within the tunnel. It will be connected to the above structures via underground services, which will require the removal of the concrete platform.

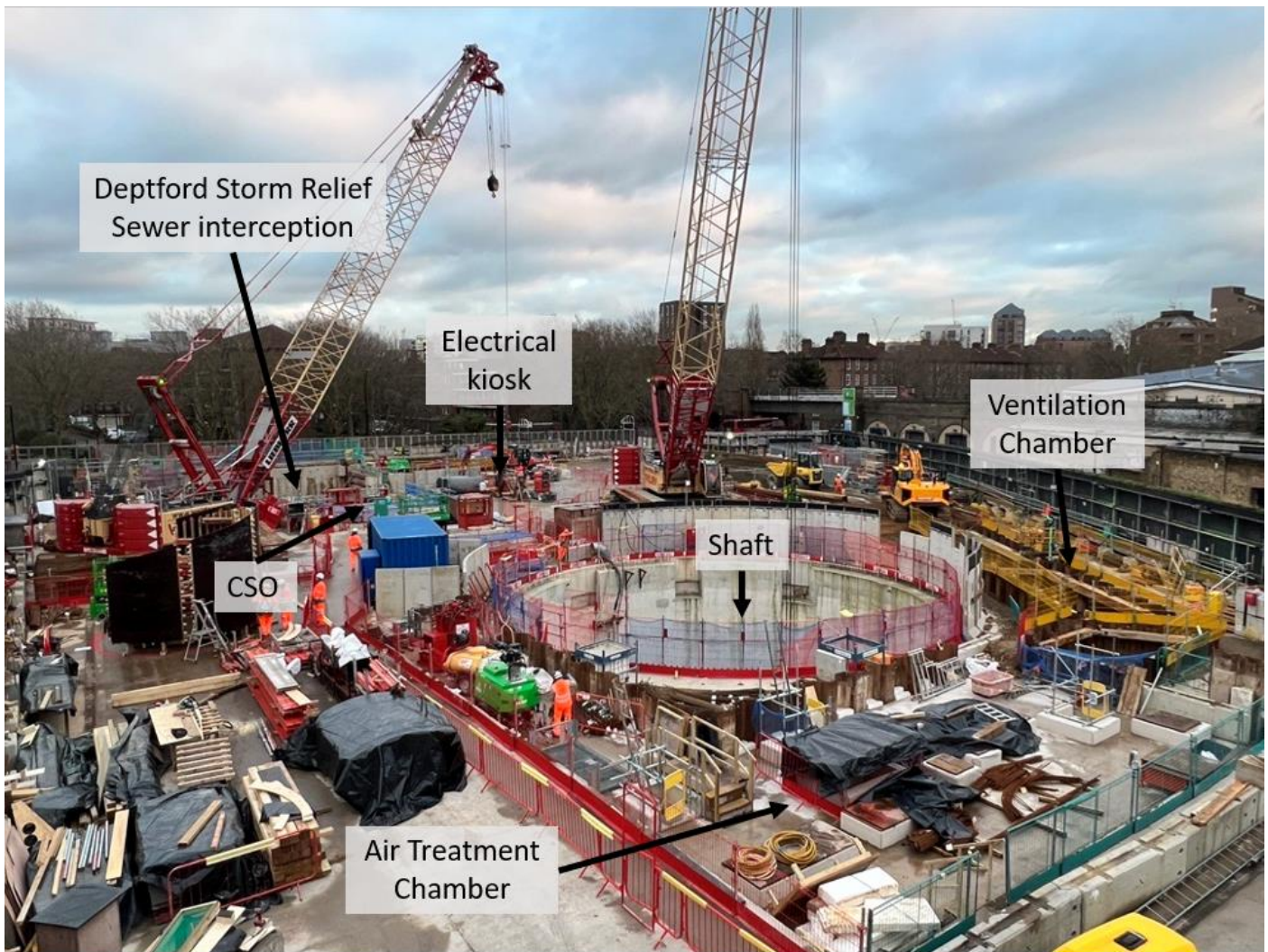
