Decision	PART AWARDED
	This claim was submitted by Southwark Council on behalf of the claimant. The Panel has not dealt with this claimant previously although the location of their property is known to the Panel.
	The Panel is aware of the activities presently on-going at the Chambers Wharf site and has also reviewed the site updates and members of the Panel have also made a number of recent visits to the site area.
	The Panel does not consider that dust from the site is likely to result in an issue at the elevated location of the property and dust at this location is unlikely to be any worse than other central London locations.
	The Panel has considered this claim very carefully in the light of the reported health issues and makes an award of two days respite a week at the standard rate until the Christmas site shutdown.
Details of the award	With respect to the request for 'Doggy Day Care', the Panel is unaware of any exceptional circumstances that would justify this and hence no award is made.
	The request for secondary glazing is refused as the property was not identified in a Trigger Action Plan and it is not considered by the Panel that noise at this location would be at such a level as to warrant consideration of the installation of secondary glazing, notwithstanding the difficulties which would otherwise result with respect to ventilation of the property.
	The request for assistance in permanently relocating away from the area is not something that the Panel or Tideway can help with. The claimant should engage with Southwark Council to see if they can assist in any way.

Details of the award	This claim was previously considered and determined at ICP meeting # 238 on the 26th of September 2023. At that meeting the following was agreed:
	"The Panel notes the request to backdate the award; however, the previous award was explicit in that it took account of previous disturbance which is why the award was extended to the end of October 2023.
	With respect to the redecoration of the property, the Panel has determined to make an award of access to temporary accommodation for one week whilst redecoration is ongoing."
	The claimant has now requested that the award should be extended to two weeks as apparently that is how long the works will take. The Panel is now aware of the extent of the redecorating works which are to be carried out.



	Accordingly, the Panel extends the temporary accommodation award to two weeks in total subject to the works lasting that long.

	The property location is known to the Panel, and it is noted that it has views directly towards the acoustic shed and therefore experiences noise from those construction activities that occur in that area.
	The Panel has very carefully considered the personal circumstances of the claimant and their requirements for a quiet work environment.
Details of the award	The Panel has determined that, based on the information available to it, an award of three days a week access to an alternative workspace is made until the Christmas site shutdown. The cost of the alternative workspace should be agreed with Tideway in advance.
	The Panel considered the request for a respite holiday; however, the Panel could not identify any specific over-riding health reasons why this should be granted.
	The Panel notes the request for financial compensation for loss of rental income; however, any such claim would need to provide specific information with respect to past rentals and recent efforts to rent out a room.
	If the claimant still requires a home visit from the Panel, then this can be arranged.

Details of the award	The Panel is aware of the personal circumstances of the claimant and the activities presently on-going at the Chambers Wharf site and has also reviewed the site updates and members of the Panel have also made a number of recent visits to the site area. The claimant's property faces towards the acoustic shed and the Panel is aware of those construction activities which have recently occurred on the east side of the site. Members of the Panel have previously carried out a home visit to the claimant's property.
	The Panel notes that the claimant previously turned down the offer of a secondary glazing system offered through the Trigger Action Plan procedure which would have mitigated noise from the site.
	The Panel has determined that, based on all of the information available to it, to make an award of two days respite a week for all family members normally resident at the property and for a carer until the Christmas shutdown of the site. The award is at the standard rate.
	Note that this award is subject to all receipts being made available to Tideway for previous payments.
	With respect to relocation, the Panel has determined that, based on the identified construction programme and the personal circumstances of the claimant as identified to the Panel, an award of alternative temporary accommodation is not made.
