	The Panel is fully aware of the current works being undertaken at the GREPS site associated with the dismantling of the acoustic shed where works at night are required due to the proximity of the DLR.
	The Panel has considered this claim very carefully and has decided to take a precautionary approach with respect to the claimant's health and makes an award until the end of February 2024 when it will be reviewed if a further claim is made.
