

WEEKLY SITE UPDATE



8 March 2024

THIS WEEK

The site team continued dismantling the acoustic enclosure (as seen this afternoon in the image below). We also continued:

- construction of the capping beam on the western side of the site. This will connect the new permanent river wall to the existing river wall. This work included installing steel reinforcement, concrete pours and the periodic breaking of concrete
- drainage and ducting works, including using an excavator for concrete breakout
- constructing the electrical and control kiosk adjacent to the rear of Fountain Green Square, as part of the long term architectural and landscaping works
- dismantling the Water Treatment Plant
- demobilising a crane for removal from the site on Monday evening (11 March) after 8:00 p.m.

THIS WEEKEND

- Saturday morning: breaking concrete and excavation in preparation for piling works
- Saturday morning: work to continue dismantling the acoustic enclosure

NEXT WEEK

- Dismantling the acoustic enclosure will continue, with barges removing material
- We will continue with capping beam works for the new river wall, with some periodic concrete breaking, steel fixing and concrete pours
- Staff will be working on the electrical and control kiosk, on the eastern side of the site
- Dismantling the Water Treatment Plant, on the west side of the site
- There is also planned drainage and ducting work, including use of an excavator for concrete breakout

WORKING HOURS

Certain activities, such as barge movements within the river foreshore for the removal of the noise enclosure and those that are dependent on the tide, may take place between 5 am and 10 pm.

We have stopped working overnight inside the acoustic enclosure.

OTHER NEWS – Section 106 Community Enhancement Fund

Under the project's Section 106 agreement, a Community Enhancement Fund of £1million was allocated to improve and enhance the area around our Chambers Wharf site. Funding can be spent on any positive project idea which can benefit the community within the area around Chambers Wharf and can be properly maintained in the future.

The current submission closed at the end of February and the voting panel is due to meet in the near future to vote on the submissions. We will bring you more information then.
