
EARL PUMPING STATION

The team at the Earl Pumping Station site is going to be removing a redundant flume (see image below). This is the large pipe that passes through our Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) that carries flows into the Thames Water pumping station during rainstorms.

This marks the start of commissioning for the Thames Tideway Tunnel at the site and will be the first time sewerage has entered our new CSO.

The site team will begin earlier, from 6 am, when Thames Water operational staff start work, as we will be working together to isolate parts of the system. These extended working hours (Monday – Friday 6:00 – 18:00. Saturday 8:00 – 13:00) will begin on Tuesday 28 May and will last for up to eight weeks.

There will be no concrete breaking ahead of our regular working hours, which begin at 8 am.



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Following all construction on the site, we will complete planned landscaping before demobilising, which is currently planned for February 2025.
