	The property is outside the fast-track designated area.
	The claimant states that they have suffered for the past 5 years with lots of noise and dust, and that they can't take the noise from the cofferdam removal and the claimant's son works nights and needs to sleep during the day.
	Various supporting evidence has been requested but only two photos of the views from the property are provided, i.e. there is no medical evidence and no employer confirmation.
	They are claiming for:
Details of the award	• 2 days' respite away from the property for the claimant and her son during the noisy works.
	The ICP is aware of the ongoing, significant works at the CHAWF site and that a fast-track claim procedure has been put in place. The site updates clearly show very significant activity with cofferdam removal et al.
	From the above and previous information and discussions, it is clear that significant works are ongoing and will be for some time. The Panel has therefore determined to make an award of 2 days respite/person/ week at the standard rate until the end of September 2024.

Details of the award	Most simply, I would like to apply for an extension for the term of compensation so there's no disruption to my work. I would like respite to run up to Spring 2025, or at least when you think there will be no more noise disruption.
	The Panel is entirely aware of the forward programme of construction works at the CHAWF site and extends the existing studio access award until April 2025.

Details of the award	The claimant is claiming:  Compensation Air purifier Respite from the property A choice of paid activities so the children are not constantly breathing in the polluted air from the site.  The Panel is fully aware of the forward programme of works on the site; however, the Panel considers that noise impacts are very much less at this property than for those occupiers of properties with a direct view towards the construction site. Accordingly, the Panel makes an award of 1 day of respite a week for all family members at the standard rate until the end of September 2024.  The Panel has considered the request for an air purifier; however, based on various site visits in the area and the monthly air quality monitoring reports, the Panel does not consider that air quality or dust is an issue particularly for west facing properties. Accordingly, no further award is made.  With respect to the presence of rats in the building, this issue is for the owners of the building to resolve.

	The Panel Chair and Noise & Vibration Specialist undertook a home visit on 14th of July 2023 and were able to observe the extent to which noise affected the property at that time and also dust on the windows etc.
	At ICP meeting # 257, following a recent claim, and having considered that claim, the ICP determined as follows:
Details of the award	The Panel has considered this claim very carefully with respect to the level of site activity and the potential for significant noise effects to occur at the claimants' property; however, on the basis of the evidence available to the Panel, no award is made.
	However, the claimants have appealed that decision directly to the ICP.
	The Chair of the ICP, as an urgent request for another claimant, visited the premises on the 4th of June 2024. When the Chair visited, the breaking out noise was incessant and very disturbing. Whilst the site stated that they would complete the breaking out works on the 5 <sup>th</sup> of June 2024, it seems to the Panel that the southern part of the site may well be active soon.
	The Panel has considered the claim very carefully and has determined to make an award of 2 days respite a week for both the claimant and his partner until the end of July 2024 at the standard rate.
	With respect to air conditioning costs, the Panel makes an award at the standard rate.

	The Panel has carefully considered all of the information available and has determined to make an award of two days respite a week until the end of September 2024 at the standard rate. It was the Panel's consideration that the circumstances of the claimants did not warrant the request for four days respite a week.
Details of the award	The claimant has apparently come back to the ICP requesting additional respite days, but no further information has been forthcoming to support the claim.
	The Panel is fully aware of the on-going works at the construction site and note that the site hoarding provides a significant level of noise mitigation.
	The Panel has not received any compelling information that leads it to consider that the earlier award should be amended in any way and therefore the request for additional mitigation is not awarded.
