	This claimant lives by himself and is disabled and has a carer. He He is complaining of the constant noise, vibration and dust and has
	had to buy two air purifiers and is seeking:
	Noise cancelling headphones.
	Compensation for the air purifiers he has had to purchase.
	Payment for cleaning.
	General compensation.
Details of the award	The ICP is aware of the ongoing, significant works at the CHAWF site and that a fast-track claim procedure has been put in place. The site updates clearly show very significant activity with cofferdam removal et al.
	The programme update of the 10 th of June and the weekly site update of 21 June 2024 have been taken into consideration. The Panel note the claimant's comments in respect of dust, although from their observations they do not consider that dust is at such a level other than the usual levels for inner London locations.
	From the above and previous information and discussions, it is clear that significant works at the site are ongoing and will



	be for some time. Accordingly, taking into account the health issues of the claimant and the fact that he would not be able to utilise the fast-track award system, the Panel has determined to make the following award: • Noise cancelling headphones to a maximum standard cost; • Running costs of the air purifiers at a standard rate; and • Two days of respite payment a week at the standard rate until the end of September 2024 (Note: Recognising that the claimant cannot leave the property, this payment may, as an exception, be utilised if the claimant so wishes for takeaway meals, replacement filters for the air purifiers or cleaning costs with appropriate receipts provided). The Panel does not make retrospective payments for any other costs which may have been incurred other than in exceptional circumstances and therefore no compensation is awarded in respect of the costs of the air purifiers which the claimant purchased previously. 	The programme update of the 10th of June and the weekly site update of 21 June 2024 have been taken into consideration.
	From the above and previous information and discussions, it is clear that significant works are ongoing at the site and will be for some time. Accordingly, taking into account the significant health issues of the claimant, the Panel has determined to make an award of a one-week holiday break for the claimant and her son (the claimant should liaise with the Tideway Mitigation Team in respect of allowable costs). This is in addition to the fast-track award.

And if I keep the windows open it gets dusty and I can't hear phone or video call conversations, which is important as these are part of
	my work.



	Additionally the site still has lights at night so the combination of light then along with noise early in the morning disturbs my sleep.
	The ICP is aware of the ongoing, significant works at the CHAWF site and that a fast-track claim procedure has been put in place. The site updates clearly show very significant activity with cofferdam removal etc
	The programme update of the 10th of June 2024 and the weekly site update of the 21st of June were taken into consideration.
	This claim falls under the fast-track system determined by the ICP and, depending upon the number of people (evidenced to be living full time) at the property, the award is to be made up until the end of September 2024, as follows:
	1. For each adult who is normally resident in the property: 2 days respite/ week at the standard rate.
	2. For each child, over the age of one year, who does not attend school, 2 days respite/week at the standard rate.
	3. For each child who would normally attend school during the term time week: 1 day of respite per week to be taken at the weekend.
	4. During school holidays, for each child who would normally attend school, 2 days respite per week at the standard.
	As the claimant works from home, the Panel also make an award of an air conditioning unit plus the standard rate towards the running costs. An award is also made of noise cancelling headphones to a maximum standard cost.

	The ICP is aware of the ongoing, significant works at the CHAWF site and that a fast-track claim procedure has been put in place. The site updates clearly show very significant activity with cofferdam removal etc
	The programme update of the 10th of June 2024 and the weekly site update of the 21st of June were taken into consideration.
	The Panel has determined that the family is eligible for a fast-track award and therefore the following award is made until the end of September 2024:
Details of the award	For each adult who is normally resident in the property: 2 days respite/ week at the standard rate.
	2. For each child, over the age of one year, who does not attend school, 2 days respite/week at the standard rate.
	3. For each child who would normally attend school during the term time week: 1 day of respite per week to be taken at the weekend.
