Details of the award	The claimant states that they are unable to use their balcony due to the noise and dust during the working hours, especially when concrete breaking and pile driving occurs. He also states that, as the building is listed, they cannot fit double glazing to the windows. He says that they are greatly disturbed by the work and feel especially affected during the commissioning phase and that they are both over retirement age. There is no mention of any medical issues.



	The ICP is aware of the ongoing, significant works at the CHAWF site. The site updates clearly show very significant activity across the site with cofferdam removal et al.
	The programme for the site works as provided at the Chambers Wharf Community Liaison Working Group presentation of Tuesday 2nd of July and programme updates, the most recent from Jim Avant, Deputy Programme Director of the 1st of July 2024 were taken into consideration.
	The Panel has considered this claim very carefully taking into account the circumstances of the claimants and the location of their property in relation to the construction site. The claimants have requested compensation, and the Panel has determined to make an award of one day of respite a week until the end of September 2024. Respite is at the standard rate.

	The Panel has determined that, mindful of the personal circumstances of the family, in this case, the previous respite award up until the end of August 2024 may be combined into a one-week holiday break at an equivalent cost to the weekly respite award.
	The Tideway Mitigation Team will advise the claimant on all aspects of funding related to the award.

Details of the award	The Panel can confirm that all aspects of the claim within the information pack were previously considered including information previously provided with respect to her health issues and note that, whilst there was mention of a therapist, no letter was provided at that time. Additionally, there was no mention in the claim form of a request for noise cancelling headphones or an air conditioning unit.
	The Panel has determined that, based on the information now available to the Panel, no award is made for an air conditioning unit as the windows on the south facing façade of the building can be opened to provide adequate ventilation.
	With respect to the request for noise cancelling headphones, an award is made for these to be purchased to a maximum standard cost.
	The therapists' undated letter has been taken into account; and on balance the Panel has determined to make an award of funding for two days therapist costs a month until the end of December 2024.
	It should be noted that invoice receipts will need to be provided to the Tideway Mitigation Team.
