Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

September 2024

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on two occasions in September 2024.

1. 10 September 2024 (ICP Meeting #264)

Purpose

To determine medical, special and fast-track claims.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Noise Specialist; and
- Medical Specialist

The Panel:

- Met via video conference to consider 13 claims. These claims mainly consisted of respite claims. One claim was a medical case claim and five claims were awarded under the current fast-track scheme.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at:
 - Chambers Wharf; and
 - o Kirtling Street

Other than those fast-track awards, which were issued without the need to wait for an ICP meeting, the minutes of the awards were issued within four working days of the meeting.
