Decision	INFORMATION UPDATE
	The claimants appealed the previous decision of the ICP to the ICC: Complaint
	ICP panel has only taken two durations into account for noise exceedance (a. Ten days out of any period of 15 consecutive days, or b. 40 days in any six-month period). However, there is a 3rd duration which should be taken into consideration in determining an exceedance of noise levels for houseboats for the current mitigation claim assessment and any future mitigation assessment.
Details of the award	The ICC concluded that:
	"On that basis, therefore, I uphold your appeal and am referring your claim back to the ICP for re-evaluation".
	The Panel has taken into account the appeal decision made by the ICC and reconfirms the Panel's decision that access to temporary accommodation should cease. This decision was previously made in the knowledge that the marine piling and other associated works were not due to commence for several months, and no programme of works had been provided at that time.

	The Panel is grateful to the claimants and the ICC for highlighting the provisions of the DCO Schedule 3 PW17 2.3.3 and the Panel is able to confirm that, as and when further relevant information becomes available with respect to the works, and associated noise predictions, then the Panel will be mindful to apply the provisions of the DCO Schedule in any future decision making. 	There are no stated medical issues.
	From site information, the vibration appears to have been generated by sheet piling at a small construction site in the Deptford Church Street Road to provide access to the Bronze Street Sewer. Information from the TT Engagement Manager was taken into.
	Recognising the disturbance that has previously occurred and the potential for further disturbance which could affect the claimants WFH arrangements, the Panel has determined to make an award of one day of respite a week per person for three weeks. The respite award is at the standard rate. The respite should be taken prior to the week ending 15 th December 2024.
