Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

November 2024

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on two occasions in November 2024.

1. 12 November 2024 (ICP Meeting #268)

Purpose

To determine medical, and compensation (loss of rent) claims.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Noise Specialist;
- Medical Specialist; and
- Compensation Specialists

The Panel:

- Met via video conference to consider 3 claims. Two claims were medical case claims (one of which was deferred as the claimant is not residing at the property currently and the other was not eligible under the Fast-Track Scheme but was provided a respite award in any event). The third claim was for loss of rent
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at Chambers Wharf.

The minutes of the awards were issued within four working days of the meeting.

2. 26 November 2024 (ICP Meeting #269)

Purpose

To determine one claim and a referral from the ICC.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Medical Specialist; and
- Noise Specialist.

The Panel:

- Met via video conference to consider two claims, one of which was a claimant who had
 previously been rehoused who had made an appeal to the ICC (after their previous claim at
 ICP meeting #266 was not awarded). The ICC upheld the appeal and requested that it be
 reviewed again by the ICP. No amendment was made to the award decision.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at:
 - o Chambers Wharf; and
 - Deptford Church Street

The minutes were issued within seven working days of the meeting although details of the respite award made was communicated in advance to the claimant by ICP Admin.
