	At ICP meeting # 261 held on 29th of July 2024, this claimant was awarded:
	The Panel has considered this claim very carefully in the light of the previous award which we understand ultimately could not be taken at that time. Accordingly, the Panel makes an award of 7 months access to alternative office accommodation. The costs are to be agreed with the Tideway Mitigation Team.
Details of the award	This claimant is now requesting an extension of this award until the end of August 2025 when works at CHAWF are due to complete.
	The current information available for ongoing construction works at the CHAWF site is as follows:
	The original s.61 was for the period 1 <sup>st</sup> January to 31 <sup>st</sup> December 2024 but this is now past its end date; however, there is a dispensation in place for the period 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2025 until completion of the works at the end of August 2025 assuming works run to programme.



	The Tideway Engagement Manager has provided an update to works by e-mail dated 9 <sup>th</sup> of December 2024 which was taken into consideration together with the programme of works.  Given the above activities with high levels of construction noise
	generated at times and the potential 05:00 hrs tide related start to the cofferdam removal works, noise emissions are likely to be significant and potentially extending into the evening period.
	The Panel has considered this claim very carefully and has determined to extend the previous award in respect of access to alternative office accommodation until the end of August 2025.
