Details of the award	<p>The claimant works from home and cares for her daughter full time. The Panel is fully aware of the family circumstances and health issues as fully described by the medical specialist.</p> <p>The claimant has made multiple claims to the ICP but the last appears to have been at ICP meeting # 237 held on the 12th of September 2023</p> <p>The claimant has now come back to the ICP claiming:</p> <p><i>Having to keep track and hand in receipts for the mitigation has been extremely stressful over the years and my executive function finds it very difficult.</i></p> <p><i>Backdated mitigation of [amount redacted] for July - Dec 2018</i></p> <p><i>Works to be carried out at Nine Elms Pier 2025 £[amount redacted] respite mitigation."</i></p> <p>MC on behalf of the ICP has informed the claimant as follows:</p> <p><i>"I would like to make two points:</i></p> <p><i>1. The ICP do not make retrospective awards unless in extreme circumstances. Your claim for 2018 would not be considered as such.</i></p>

	<p>2. You have put in a figure [amount redacted] for 2025 respite mitigation. The ICP do not offer financial compensation unless in the case of evidenced business loss. What they would consider, would be daily respite for you and your family. Could you perhaps consider revising your claim and make it for daily respite or perhaps you would like to claim for alternative office space if you have to work from home?"</p> <p>The issue with the piling has arisen before following a claim from other parties.</p> <p>The Panel has considered the claimant's requests for financial compensation and notes that the financial compensation that they originally received was a one-off payment and that was in respect of the ICP agreeing the information provided in the FLO – ICP Information Pack, dated 10 January 2016. Since that time, the claimant has received a number of respite awards.</p> <p>The Panel has taken into consideration all of the information available, which has included visits the Panel has made to the claimant's home and the KRTST construction site area.</p> <p>The Panel has now been made aware that the marine piling works will take place commencing on the 13th of January 2025 with an anticipated duration of 5 days including approximately 2 days of marine piling.</p> <p>The Panel has determined to make an award of 5 days respite/ week for the claimant and her daughter for the week commencing 13th January 2025. The respite is at the standard rate. If the marine piling works extend into a further week, then the claimant and her daughter will be entitled to a further 5 days respite.</p> <p>It should be noted that receipts must be provided to Tideway for all respite awards.</p> <p>Claimants are reminded to read the guidance information below.</p> <p><u>All awards are subject to Tideway's Guidelines for Implementation of ICP decisions.</u></p> <p><u>https://www.tideway.london/media/4138/guidelines-for-implementation-of-icp-decisions_feb-2020.pdf</u></p>
