## CHAMBERS WHARF HOARDING REMOVAL

The Tideway team is continuing to remove the cofferdam and sheet piles. The cofferdam was the temporary area of land that we built out into the river so that we could build the super sewer structures below ground. We have recently moved a jack-up barge into the middle of the site to help with these activities. We are also installing the new panels that make up the river wall.

### LOFTIE STREET

From Tuesday, 22 April, we will be working in Loftie Street at the gate. The team will be removing the current hoarding where future access to the kiosk control building will be after Tideway leaves. Pedestrian access will remain, but vehicle access may be restricted at times, including to the parking bays.

### CHAMBERS STREET

From Tuesday, 6 May, the team will begin removing the art hoarding along Chambers Street. This was designed by children from Riverside Primary School, along with artist John Walter.



Plain hoarding will then remain in place until the Tideway site team finishes at Chambers Wharf and remain around the site for the incoming developer.

The hoarding will be getting changed from May until the end of June.

- Saturday – 8am to 1pm
- Cofferdam removal activities, including barge movements, are tidally affected and may take place between 5am and 10pm
