Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

April 2025

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on two occasions in April 2025.

1. 8 April 2025 (ICP Meeting #279)

Purpose

To determine medical, special and fast-track claims (if applicable).

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Noise Specialist; and
- Medical Specialist.

The Panel:

- The Panel met via video conference to consider one medical claim, one special claim and five other claims, one of which was for a resident on a houseboat living close to Tideway's Chambers Wharf site.
- One claim was an appeal for a backdated payment which had not been awarded at a
 previous meeting. This claimant also asked the ICP to respond to several detailed queries, all
 of which were addressed in the minutes.
- These mattes were associated with Tideway works at:
 - Chambers Wharf;
 - Earl Pumping Station;
 - Greenwich Pumping Station and
 - o Carnwath Road.

The minutes were issued within four working days of the meeting.

2. 22 April 2025 (ICP Meeting #280)

Purpose

To determine medical, special and fast-track claims (if applicable).

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Medical Specialist; and
- Noise Specialist.

The Panel:

- Met via video conference to consider six claims, five of which were from claimants living on houseboats close to Tideway's Chambers Wharf site.
- One of the claims was for a resident who had misinterpreted a previous award made in March for daily respite. As the claimant works night shifts, it was determined that an award be made for overnight respite.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at Chambers Wharf.
