Details of the award	<p>The claimant's partner had a claim which was heard on 11th of March 2025.</p> <p>The claimant is making a claim for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Noise cancelling headphones</i> - <i>Respite payments so that I can take a break from the noise (e.g. for cafes to study in, hire of library study rooms for interviews, restaurant meals to socialise away from the noise).</i>

	<p>The current situation for the CHAWF site is that there is a dispensation in place for the period 1st January 2025 until completion of the works at the end of August 2025 assuming works run to programme. However, the high-level works programme indicates an end in September 2025 (see below).</p> <p>The Engagement Manager for the site has provided an update to works by e-mail dated 9th of December 2024 which was taken into consideration together with the weekly newsletter from the site team at Chambers Wharf for week commencing 5 May 2025.</p> <p>The Panel has determined that an award of noise cancelling headphones is made.
