Details of the award	The Panel is aware of the claimant's (husband) previous health issues and has received a brief update in respect of on-going treatment.
	Previously (at ICP meeting #262 on 13 August 2024), the Panel made an award of the fast-track scheme which took into account the claimant's health issues. The award was for 2 days respite/week at the standard rate.
	The claimant (wife) has, with the assistance of ICP Admin, submitted a new claim and is claiming for "a respite break to take her husband away prior to his next round of surgery".
	The claimant did not leave sufficient time for the Panel to consider making an award prior to the holiday, which was booked from 1 to 5 June 2025 and has subsequently requested that the Panel considers making a retrospective award on this occasion due to his poor health and upcoming surgery.
	The high-level works programme indicates an end in September 2025 and the Engagement Manager for the site has provided an update to works by email dated 9th of December 2024.
	The Chambers Wharf–Community Liaison Working Group meeting of Tuesday 11 February 2025 and the weekly site updates have also been taken into consideration:



	Although the Panel is aware of the claimant's health issues, no updated information has been received from the claimants, other than the information recorded on the claim form by ICP Admin during a telephone conversation on 11 June 2025.
	The Panel's view is that the location of their flat is far enough away that any disruption due to noise would not be enough to warrant an award of a week's respite break. However, the Panel is prepared to allow the equivalent cost of one week of the current daily respite award to be used to offset the cost of the holiday that the claimants have already taken.
