Details of the award	Previously the Panel determined that there was no loss of rent and therefore no award was made.
	The Panel has now reviewed the appeal response from the claimant.
	The Panel reviewed the previous decision and was not presented with any new evidence that persuaded it to make a different award. The Panel did, however, recognise, with hindsight, that the wording of the last decision was ambiguous. The outcome is unchanged but revised wording of the fourth paragraph of the previous decision is provided below:
	It was noted that the outgoing tenants apparently cited Tideway works as the only reason for leaving but this did not appear logical to the Panel, given that those tenants had lived through much more significant and intrusive works for 4 years and had accepted rental increases during that period. The Panel also considered it unlikely that prospective tenants would have been deterred by the remaining Tideway works.
