

Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

May 2026

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met once in May 2026.

1. 26 May 2026 (ICP Meeting #313)

Purpose

To determine:

- an appeal from a claimant who had made a complaint to the Independent Complaints Commissioner who had ruled against the appellant;
- a special claim from a night shift worker; and
- a claim for daily respite from a new houseboat owner.

In addition to the above 3 claims, the ICP determined that all standard respite awards i.e. two days respite a week at the standard cost, which were due to cease at the end of June 2026, would be automatically extended until the end of August 2026 or to whenever the significantly noisy work activities cease on the site, whichever is the sooner.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Noise Specialist; and
- Medical Specialist

The Panel:

- Met via video conference to consider the above claims which were all associated with Tideway's site at Chambers Wharf.

Minutes were issued to the 3 claimants above within two days of the meeting and the remainder of residents were advised of the automatic renewals within 6 days of the meeting.
